

BEFORE CAMP CHECKLIST

Today

- Decide when you are going to camp!
- Email your registration form.

March-April

- Send in your camp deposit as soon as possible to confirm your reservation.
- Have a meeting with your Scouts and their parents to discuss camp.
- Have a meeting with your leaders and/or the parents attending camp.
- Call and arrange for a road show with the camp staff to which you invite all campers and parents.
- Make sure all leaders and/or parents coming to camp with you will have a valid PRC for your time at camp. Check expiry dates.

May

- Go over the camp program with your Scouts so that they are familiar with it and know what they have to look forward to.
- Plan your program in consultation with your Troop.
- Plan and practice ideas for the Talent Show.
- Make sure your Camping and Outdoor Application form has been sent to your Area Commissioner.
- Decide if you are cooking yourself or taking our meal plan
- E-mail out all forms to parents for completion.
- E-mail camp forms no later than May 31st.
- Send in balance of fees by May 31st.

June

- Show your Scouts how to pack properly for camp.
- Make sure that transportation to and from camp is arranged - remember arrival is no earlier than 1 p.m. on the first Saturday and departure is by 10 a.m. the following Saturday. Supply maps to parents.
- Check for any birthdays during the week. If we have enough notice, we will do something special!

1-2 weeks before camp

- Remind everyone to have Medicare cards and any medication with them; along with the medication consent form.
- Have a packing night to make sure everyone is ready for camp.
- Pack copies of health and consent forms for your records.
- Be prepared - to have fun!
